**Preconference Speaker:** **Dominick Sanders** is currently the Computer Science Supervisor for the state of South Carolina Education Department. In this role, he is responsible for k-12 computer science education programs and professional development across the state. As a former computer science teacher and national leader, he brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to share with the education sector. As a teacher, one of his proudest moments as a teacher was during the 2019-2020 school year. For the Advanced Placement Computer Science exam, he helped his school secure a 70.8% pass rate. More scholars passed the exam and had an overall higher average score than the state of Tennessee. His female and Black and Latinx scholars had a higher passing rate than the state and global average.

His true passion is helping others and giving back by inspiring and encouraging as many underserved students as he possibly can. One of his favorite quotes is “You can be what you can’t see.” With that quote in mind, in 2019 he founded Xposure STEM. Xposure STEM is a nonprofit organization designed to empower, expose, and equip underserved boys and girls to become leading contributors to the world of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

He holds a Master’s degree from Relay Graduate School for Education and a B.S. in Computer Science from Jackson State University. He is also currently an alumnus of the Computer Science Teachers Association (CSTA) Equity Fellowship.
